

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING ACCEPTING A PROJECT LABOR AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, North Jefferson County Ambulance District (“Owner”) plans to construct an ambulance station, hereinafter referred to as the “Project”; and

WHEREAS, the Owner and the Unions are interested in furthering the development of the construction industry by maintaining the employment of skilled and trained labor on a competitive basis: and


WHEREAS, the Unions have in their membership throughout the area, members, competent, trained and qualified to perform the work required of the Owner on the Project; and

WHEREAS, the parties are desirous of assuring the cooperation in completing the Project economically, without delay or work stoppages, and wish to create an atmosphere of true labor-management cooperation; and

WHEREAS, in order to facilitate relative equity and uniform interpretation and application, the Owner and the Unions wish to mutually establish working conditions for workers employed on the Project, and further to encourage close cooperation between the Owner and the Unions to the end that a satisfactory, continuous and harmonious relationship will exist between the parties to this Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the parties recognize the Owner and its vendors will be actively involved in supervisory roles in the final installation/setup, checkout, startup, testing, inspection and training on various systems and equipment to be installed in said Project, and that in connection with such work the Owner, its vendors and their respective employees will be working in close proximity to union members.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE NORTH JEFFERSON COUNTY AMBULANCE DISTRICT, and in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants herein contained, that the parties agree and the Board of Directors accepts the following agreement, in a form substantially similar to the attached Exhibit A.
